1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Fireball, Interlake, Frontrunner, Windmill, International 110, Flying Dutchman and A Cat classes.
- 2.2 Skippers must be current members of their class associations and show proof.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may register by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fees, as shown on the form, or online at www.diyc.org.
- 2.4 A minimum of 3 boats is required to form a class.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Single Hand (A Cat) (Sat/Sun only) \$55.00
 - Double-handed classes: \$95.00
 - Triple-handed classes: \$115.00
 - Entries after March 6: add \$25.00
 - Non-members of USSA or CYA: add \$ 5.00
- The entry fee will include: Regatta merchandise coupons for skipper and crews, continental breakfast Friday, Saturday, Sunday, 1 dinner ticket (per boat), free beer keg after racing Friday and Saturday, launching and hauling, facilities, and trailer parking.
- Other fees: Additional regatta merchandise, breakfast, dinner tickets (\$13), and box lunches will be available for purchase for each day, by reservation and payment at registration.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 As many races as possible will be run for each class. A minimum of one completed race is required to constitute a series.
- 7.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed for a class, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed for a class, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded in each class based on the number of entrants.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.
- 9.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

I hereby forever and irrevocably waive, release and discharge any and all claims, liability, loss, or damages, including but not limited to claims for property damage, personal injury or death, which I may have or in the future acquire against Davis Island Yacht Club, its officers, members, employees, volunteers or agents, arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in any race or other activity sponsored or undertaken by any of them, even though such liability may arise out of their negligence or carelessness. I understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during sailboat racing, and that participants in sailboat racing occasionally sustain mortal or serious personal injuries and/or property damage as a consequence, and I knowingly assume all of the risks of sailboat racing. I agree that this waiver is binding on my heirs, representatives, successors and assigns.

I acknowledge that participants who elect to leave their boats on Davis Island Yacht Club property do so at their own risk. Neither the Club nor any members thereof make any warranty either express or implied that a boat on Club property will be safe.

I agree to be bound by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and by all other *rules* that govern this event.
