



**DIYC 2021-2022 Boat of the Year
Notice of Series**

Organizing Authority – Davis Island Yacht Club

1. RULES

This series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* except that the US Sailing prescriptions to RRS 63.1 and 63.2 shall not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY

This series is open to all boats with a valid WFPHRF certificate, or a temporary rating assigned by the DIYC Club Measurer. There is no fee to enter this Series.

3. SCHEDULE

The following events are included in this Series:

Commodore’s Cup	22-23 Jan 2022	Buoy RLC	Spinnaker Class drop-mark racing Other classes distance race, up to 25 miles

Hillsborough Bay Race	5 Mar 2022	RLC	Distance race, up to 25 miles
Tampa Bay Hospice Cup	23 April 2022	Buoy RLC	Spinnaker Class drop-mark racing Other classes reverse handicap “pursuit style” distance race, up to 25 miles
Tampa Bay to Ft Myers Race	27-28 May 2022	RLC	Distance race, about 100 miles

Please refer to DIYC’s Calendar on the website for further details on each event. Format and distance subject to change, so refer to the NoR and Sailing Instructions for each event.

4. DIVISIONS

If less than three boats are registered in each Division, boats will be assigned a Division by the Fleet Captain and the decision is final and is not subject to a request for redress. Divisions are expected to be the following:

- Spinnaker A (RLC rating less than 70)
- Spinnaker B (RLC rating between 70 and 116)
- Spinnaker C (RLC rating above 116)
- Racer-Cruiser
- Cruiser
- Multi-Hull

5. SCORING AND PRIZES

- 5.1. The series will be scored using RRS Appendix A including A5.3. The finishing position of each event will count as the series score for each boat.
- 5.2. Throws outs: When 6 or more events (5 for Spinnaker C) are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her event scores excluding her worst score. When 8 or more events (7 for Spinnaker C) are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her event scores excluding her 2 worst scores.
- 5.3. Boats must compete in at least 50% of the events to qualify for an overall series trophy, except Spinnaker-C must compete in 40%.
- 5.4. Overall DIYC BOTY Series trophies are awarded for the **top 3 places** for qualified boats in each Division.
- 5.5. The prestigious Bonanni perpetual trophy will be awarded to the top overall boat in the series by scoring the fewest points. There must be a minimum of 3 boats qualifying for BOTY in the Division to be eligible for the trophy.

6. KICKOFF PARTY

Now August 28th, 2021 – DIYC will host the BOTY series kick-off party on August 28th. The event will be held at DIYC in the Regatta Bar. While your attendance is not required to participate in the series, please try to attend - and bring your crew!

7. SEASON-END TROPHY PRESENTATION AND AWARDS PARTY

Trophies will be presented in conjunction with the *Rally to Sail Pavilion* on the summer solstice (aka *Sailstice*) weekend on 18 June 2022.
